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Covid 19 precautions.

In connection with the increasing number of people affected by Influenza - Covid 19 - here is a short update regarding rules and guidelines.



We at Svane are completely compliant with the authorities' recommendations. This applies to all employees.

Excerpt from the Danish Health Authority's website.**2. What are you recommended to do if you have symptoms of covid-19 or other respiratory infection?**

If you get symptoms of a respiratory infection, e.g. fever, cough or sore throat and feel ill, you are recommended to stay at home until you are well again. If you have mild symptoms, e.g. runny nose, sore throat, occasional cough, etc., but otherwise do not feel ill, you do not need to stay at home or be tested.

If you have symptoms, you can still see your doctor or other places in the healthcare system. You are recommended to wear a mask in the waiting room and if you take public transport.

If you are so ill that you need to speak to a doctor, or your symptoms worry you, you should call your own doctor or doctor on call/1813.

The Danish Health Authority recommends that you be tested for covid-19 if you develop symptoms of a respiratory infection and are at the same time at increased risk of a serious course of covid-19. If you test positive, you may be in the target group for early tablet treatment against covid-19.

If you are at increased risk and your test is positive for covid-19, you should contact your own doctor as soon as possible, as it is your doctor who assesses whether you can receive early treatment against covid-19.

Remember that the symptoms can also be caused by other infectious diseases, e.g. flu or pneumonia. Even if the test is not positive for covid-19, you may still need treatment and you must stay at home until you are well.

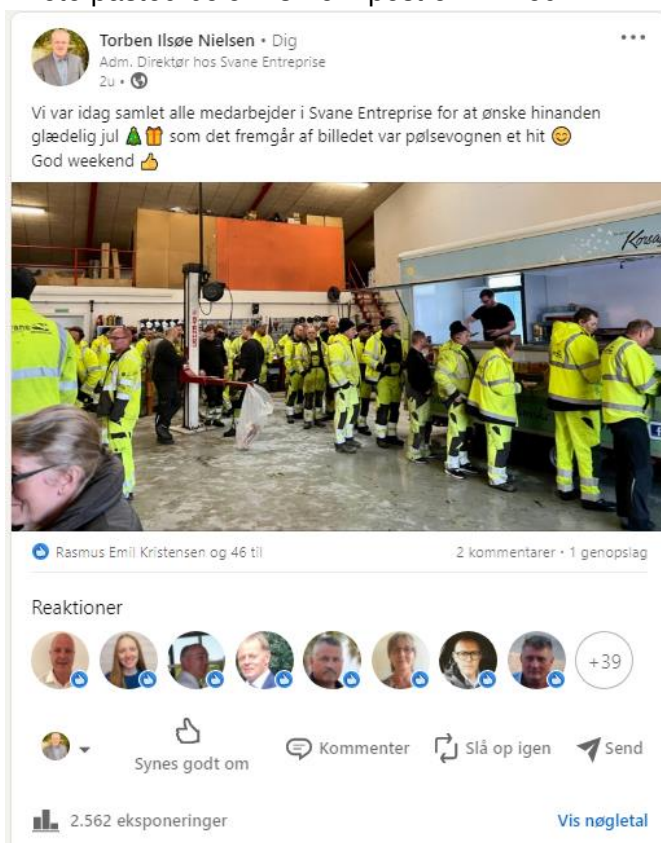
If your test is positive but you are not sick, you do not need to stay at home or contact a doctor. In this connection, staying at home means that you avoid close and long-term contact with others and thus do not attend work, leisure activities or social events, and that children do not attend school, day care etc. This means in particular that you are not with the elderly and the chronically ill, who are more susceptible to infectious diseases. You do not need to isolate yourself completely in your home. If your test is negative, but you feel sick, you may still have covid-19, as no test is 100% certain. You can also fail other things. Contact your doctor if you are concerned.

The National Board of Health recommends that you follow the infection prevention advice, regardless of whether you feel sick or not.

Various information.
